



Winterhawks Skating Center Policies & Procedures for Membership

1. The following forms have been submitted before entering the facility:

- Signed Waiver of Liability.
- Completed COVID-19 Health Questionnaire by skater and by any household member entering the facility (parents-guardians-relatives-siblings-nannies).
- Completes WSC COVID-19 Policies and Procedures Membership Guidelines.

STAY HOME if you or anyone in your family are feeling ill or have any symptoms of COVID including but not limited to: fever, chills, cough, loss of taste and smell or any answer on your COVID questionnaire changes from a “No” to “Yes”. Consult your family doctor and notify WSC.

2. Procedure to enter the facility

- Keep 6 ft distancing at all times. Reminder markers are on the floor. No congregating.
- CHECK IN by scanning your face and or ID card on the check-in kiosk to record your temperature/attendance. **By signing in you are confirming your COVID-19 questionnaire has not changed and you do not feel ill.**
- Have your temperature taken.
- Wash your hands for at least 20 seconds with soap and water.
- Arrive fully dressed or place your personal gear at your designated sitting area.
- After skates have been put on. Move all gear into cold area (after earlier group has exited building). Once you've taken the ice you will not be allowed back into the warm area/lobby of the rink (without prior permission).
- At all times be mindful of the 6 ft distance rule during training.
- After your training session. Remove all personal gear, use sanitizing stations in cold area of rink. **DO NOT enter warm area/lobby area without prior permission.**
- Exit the building within 10 minutes after training has finished.
- All personal belongings, training gear and trash are to be taken home after your training period.

3. Policies

- Personal water bottles only. We prefer you to use a disposable bottle with a screw cap.
- No food or snacks are allowed.
- Personal equipment is to be used at all times. No sharing.
- Parents/guardians/relatives/nannies/siblings are requested to drop skater off at the curb and wait in the parking lot. In order to enter facility you must receive prior approval and have a completed Covid-19 questionnaire on file.
- No one other than coaches and staff are allowed on the ice or inside offices.
- Showers are off limits to the public.
- 6 ft distancing required at all times. Follow all barriers and floor markings.
- Practice a one-in ; one-out restroom policy. Max two persons in restroom. No congregating in restrooms.
- If you need to use the restroom, ask for coach's permission.
